Paintings and sculptures that dealt with Jewish subjects, particularly with the agony of the East European Jewish experience of World War II, remained taboo. The dissident movement of the 1970s and 1980s, which produced a Jewish revival of sorts in music and in literature, similarly inspired a subversive Jewish turn among Jewish painters and sculptors of the Eastern bloc. East European Jews who first entered into the making of painting and sculpture in the nineteenth century did so within an imperial context. They began as Jewish provincials; in the professional pursuit of art lay their geographic and cultural emancipation from the social and confessional boundaries of their local Jewish communities. Scottish art in the nineteenth century is the body of visual art made in Scotland, by Scots, or about Scottish subjects. This period saw the increasing professionalisation and organisation of art in Scotland. Major institutions founded in this period included the Institution for the Encouragement of the Fine Arts in Scotland, the Royal Scottish Academy of Art, the National Gallery of Scotland, the Scottish National Portrait Gallery and the Glasgow Institute.
