Although regretting the anti-Japanese clauses, President Coolidge signed the bill and the oriental exclusion Act of 1924 became law. Feeling against those of Japanese ancestry did not die after this exclusion act. Among such groups Grodzins in Americans Betrayed lists: The California Farm Bureau Federation, The Grower-Shipper Vegetable Association, The Associated Farmers, The Pacific League, The Merchants and Manufacturers Association of Los Angeles, The Native Sons of the Golden West and the American Legion. 5.
