It is a process of problem solving for many professionals " to try and determine the core components of a person's psychological or mental health problems, personality, IQ, or some other component. It is also a process that helps identifies not just weaknesses of a person, but also their strengths. Psychological testing is not a single test or even a single type of test. It encompasses a whole body of dozens of research-backed tests and procedures of assessing specific aspects of a person's psychological makeup. Some tests are used to determine IQ, others are used for personality, and still others for something else.
