Basking sharks are generally solitary animals, so scientists are puzzled as to why almost 1,400 of the creatures have been spotted congregating on a stretch of the North American coast. After the whale shark, basking sharks are the world's largest fish. They can grow up to 32-feet long and weigh over five tons. Along with the whale shark and megamouth shark, basking sharks are the only species of shark that eat plankton. (And no, they don't eat humans). For over three decades, scientists have been documenting whales in the waters stretching from Nova Scotia to Long Island.
