If you want to shoot high key indoors, it's best to have some studio lighting available, preferably 3-4 flashes: two on your subject, two on the backdrop. Also, make sure your camera's settings are optimized to let in lots of light. Make sure there's enough to brighten the scene considerably without blowing out the subject. The shooter isn't confident of the correction they're making after a miss, so they dial the correction but will not hold center for the next shot. In a "hedge your bets" mindset, the shooter will shade in the direction of the correction on the target. If you aren't willing to trust your corrections and to let them be wrong, you aren't going to learn how to make better corrections. However it should be treated as an important part of a solid shooting foundation. Get out shooting and challenge yourself. Identify your weaknesses and use lessons from the book to bolster them into strengths instead of sticking with the things you're already doing well.
