In the Boston Police Strike, Boston police officers went on strike on September 9, 1919. They sought recognition for their trade union and improvements in wages and working conditions. Police Commissioner Edwin Upton Curtis denied that police officers had any right to form a union, much less one affiliated with a larger organization like the American Federation of Labor (AFL). Attempts at reconciliation between the Commissioner and the police officers, particularly on the part of Boston's Mayor Andrew Critics say the police strike in Espirito Santo is another example of the government's loose grip on control. Espirito Santo has long been one of Brazil's most crime-ridden states. There were 1,000 killings there last year, yet overworked police officers make a starting salary of just \$600 a month, among the lowest in the country, according to the state police officers' union. Because they provide an essential service, state police are legally forbidden to go on strike in Brazil. But the officers in Espirito Santo found a loophole: They would show up at the station every morning in uniform, ready to work. But once they were inside, their spouses and family members surrounded the headquarters and refused to let them patrol the streets, demanding higher payment and better working conditions. Police have refused to go on patrol until their demands for a salary rise are met. Their move follows a police walkout in Cordoba province last week which also led to lootings, and which was settled after the governor almost doubled officers' pay. Widespread unrest. In 10 provinces police remain on strike, while in another seven, officers say they may have reached a deal. The governor of Buenos Aires, Argentina's most populous province, managed to avert a strike by agreeing to almost double the entry-level salary of the police to 8,500 pesos (Â£830; \$1,360) a month. On Sunday night, a young man was electrocuted in the city of Concordia, in north-eastern Entre Rios province, when he came in contact with loose cabling in a looted shop.
