Like his New Zealand contemporaries such as A. R. D. Fairburn, Stephensen sought to develop a distinct national culture for his homeland. His work as a publisher and political activist was dedicated to fostering this sense of Australianity. Like many others of the Right, such as Ezra Pound, Roy Campbell, and Knut Hamsun, Stephensen has o
