The 17 results are searing and ensnaring, clever, erotic, and disquieting tales of anger and subterfuge, desperation and revenge. I thought all the stories were excellent, but several stick out because they were as plainly written as Hopper plainly painted. One of the best was by Gail Levin, author of several bios of Hopper and curator of collections of Hopper's who writes in the voice of "Gail Levin" and describes a Baptist minister who was the religious councilor to Edward Hopper, his wife, and his sister in their last years. This collection of stories is an effort by the several authors to come up with a back story for each Hopper listed.
